Easter Sunday and the Lord's Resurrection from the Dead

**The Lord is risen, indeed!
Let us rejoice and be glad.**

With these glorious words the Church and the New Testament proclaims the resurrection of Jesus from the dead and the completion of our redemption. We have spent Lent pondering the Seven Last Words of Jesus in his earthly life. Today we begin to reflect on the first words of the Risen Lord. In each of the post-resurrection appearances, Jesus has the same message! "Peace! It is I."

It might seem strange to us that those to whom he appeared didn't recognize him. But they needed to be reassured that it was indeed the Risen Lord.

Today we might spend our time on the Emmaus story. It seems to address the issues quite well and gives direction for those of us seeking to follow the Crucified and Risen Lord.

The story in Luke 24 tells us of two of the disciples who have left Jerusalem and were headed for the village of Emmaus about six miles from Jerusalem. They are acting like most humans who have been disillusioned by one whom they respected. Luke lets us appreciate their state of psyche. They are despondent that Jesus died and they haven't a clue about His resurrection. They heard other disciples affirm the resurrection, but they cannot believe. Their faith is too weak. Jesus comes upon them and walks with them in this state of psyche.

Instead of doing something flashy, Jesus walks with and talks with them. He asks them questions, modeling for us how we evangelize others who do not yet believe. He recalls for them all that has been said about the Messiah from Moses to the prophets. They listen to the information but seem unable to function with that knowledge. They are lacking the depth of faith formation which is necessary for belief in the resurrection.

Then it becomes time for a meal and they invited Jesus to join them. He does so and when he blesses the bread, they recognize him and he vanishes from their sight. Once they have accepted the truth in faith, the physical presence of Jesus is no longer necessary! Instead of spending the night and returning to Jerusalem the following morning, they run back to Jerusalem (six miles much of which is uphill!). They find the others in the upper room and as they try to tell their story, they hear that Jesus has appeared to some of the others and that he has been recognized in the breaking of the bread.

Now their faith is complete. Can we this week ponder what this event calls forth from us? How strong is my faith? Do I believe He is risen indeed?



Domingo de Pascua y la Resurrección del Señor

**El Señor ha resucitado, en verdad!
Regocijémonos y alegrémonos.**

¡Con estas palabras la Iglesia y el Nuevo Testamento proclaman la Resurrección de Jesús de los muertos y el complemento de nuestra redención. Hemos pasado la Cuaresma pensando en las Últimas Siete Palabras de Jesús en su vida terrenal. A hoy comenzamos a reflexionar en las primeras palabras del Señor Resucitado.

En cada aparición después de Su Resurrección, Jesús tiene el mismo mensaje! "Paz! ¡Soy Yo!"

Pueda aparecer extraño a nosotros que aquellos a quien el apareció no lo reconocieron. Pero necesitaban asegurarse que en verdad era el Señor Resucitado.

A hoy podríamos pasar nuestro tiempo en la historia de Emaús. Parece que dirige muy bien a la solución y da direcciones para aquellos de nosotros que estamos buscando seguir el Señor Crucificado y Resucitado.

La historia en Lucas 24 nos dice de dos de los discípulos que se han ido de Jerusalén y que iban hacia el pueblo de Emaús como a seis millas de Jerusalén. Están actuando como la mayoría de humanos que han sido desilusionados por uno que respectaban. Lucas nos deja apreciar su estado de psiquis. Están tristes que Jesús murió y no tiene indicio de Su resurrección. Escucharon otros discípulos afirmando la resurrección, pero ellos no lo pueden creer. Su fe esta débil. Jesús los alcanza y anda con ellos en este estado de psiquis.

En vez de hacer algo relumbrante, Jesús anda y habla con ellos. El les hace preguntas, modelando para nosotros como debemos evangelizar a otros que todavía no creen. El les recuerda de lo que se ha dicho del Mesías de Moisés ha los profetas. Escuchan a la información pero parece que no pueden funcionar con esa información. Les falta la profundidad de formación de fe que es necesario para creer en la resurrección.

Luego llega la hora de comer y ellos invitan a Jesús a reunirse con ellos. El lo hace y cuando bendice el pan, ellos lo reconocen y el se desaparece de vista. En vez que han aceptado la verdad en fe, la presencia física de Jesús ya no es necesaria! En vez de quedarse la noche y regresar a Jerusalén la mañana siguiente, regresan corriendo a Jerusalén (¡seis millas lo cual es casi todo cuesta arriba!) Ellos encuentran los demás en el cuarto de arriba y cuando intentan decir su historia, ellos escuchan que Jesús se ha aparecido a algunos de los demás y que el ha sido reconocido en el quebramiento del pan.

Ahora su fe esta completa. ¿Esta semana podremos ponderar que es lo que este evento nos llama hacer en adelante? ¡Que tan fuerte es mi fe? ¿Creo yo que verdaderamente El ha resucitado?

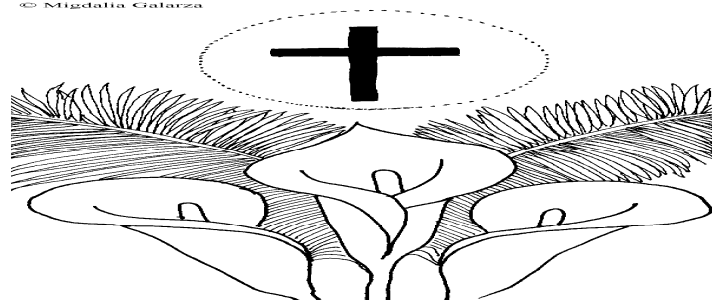
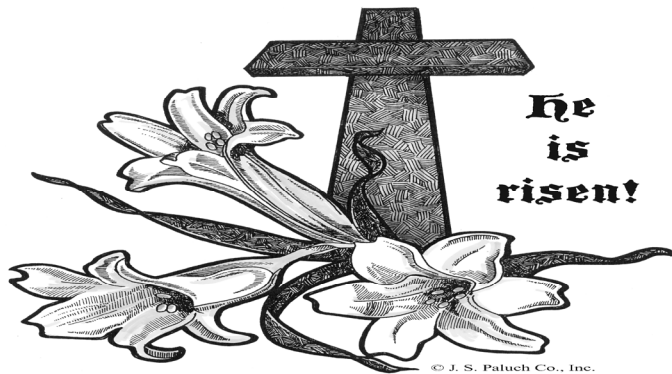
