**The Revised Roman Missal and the  
Responsorial Psalm and the Second  
Reading**

On Sundays and major feasts there is another Scripture Reading inserted between the First Reading and the Gospel. In this case the first reading is from the Old Testament and the Second one is from the New Testament (non-Gospel). We have the opportunity of being better nourished by the Word.

Between these two readings is the Responsorial Psalm. This portion of the readings consists of a few verses of an appropriate Psalm and a line which is repeated by the assembly. As we listen to the verses, our portion of this reading is to interact with the psalm by repeating the antiphon provided. Thus it becomes the prayer of the assembly – lector and community.

The First and Second Readings end with the pronouncement “The Word of the Lord” by the lector. To this the assembly responds “Thanks be to God.” Thus we affirm our faith in the Scriptures and our belief that it is indeed the Word of the Lord.

The Second Reading calls each of us in the assembly to ponder the same text. Throughout the world, this is what we do. This is how we are joined to each other throughout the world in the universal prayer of the Church.

When there is no second reading, the responsorial psalm is followed by the Gospel acclamation. However, when there is a Second Reading, the Gospel acclamation follows it and precedes the Gospel Reading.

After the assembly answers “Thanks be to God,” there is to be a short period of silence. During this time we reflect on what we have heard and see what we are challenged to do.

When the Gospel acclamation is sung, we acknowledge the primacy of the Gospels in the Scripture. The posture of standing is to show respect for the Gospel Reading which follows.

As we prepare to hear the Gospel Reading, we again reflect on the acclamation which gives us the theme of the day’s reading. It is a challenge given to us. Are we preparing to hear all that the Gospel will teach us? Are we attentive to the Word with the ear of our heart?

**El Misal Romano Revisado y El Salmo  
Responsorial y la Segunda Lectura**

En los domingos y días festivos hay otra Lectura de las Escrituras en medio de la Primera Lectura y el Evangelio. En este caso la primera lectura del Antiguo Testamento y la Segunda vendrá del Nuevo Testamento (no Evangelios). Así tenemos la oportunidad de ser mejor alimentados por la Palabra.

En medio de estas dos Lecturas esta el Salmo Responsorial. Esta porción de las lecturas consiste en unos cuantos versos del Salmo apropiado y una línea de estos es repetida por la asamblea. Escuchando los versos, nuestra porción de estos es para interactuar con el salmo repitiendo la antifona que se nos da. Así que esta se convierte en la oración de la asamblea — lector y la comunidad.

La Primera y Segunda lecturas terminan con la recitación de la frase “Palabra de Dios” por el lector. Con esto la asamblea responde “Demos Gracias a Dios.” Así afirmamos nuestra fe en las Escrituras y nuestra crianza que esa es en verdad la Palabra de Dios.

La Segunda Lectura llama a cada uno de nosotros en la asamblea a meditar este texto. En todo el mundo esto es lo que hacemos. Es la forma en que nos hemos reunido todos alrededor del mundo en la oración universal de la Iglesia.

Cuando no hay una segunda lectura, el salmo responsorial es seguido por la proclamación del Evangelio. Sin embargo, cuando hay una Segunda Lectura, el Salmo responsorial sigue y precede a la proclamación del Evangelio.

Cuando termina la proclamación la asamblea responde: “Demos Gracias a Dios,” y es seguida por un corto periodo de silencio. Durante este tiempo reflexionamos en lo que escuchamos y vemos qué clase de reto nos brinda.

Cuando la Proclamación del Evangelio es cantada, podemos ver la primacía de los Evangelios en las Escrituras. La postura de estar de pie es para mostrar respeto hacia la Lectura del Evangelio que sigue.

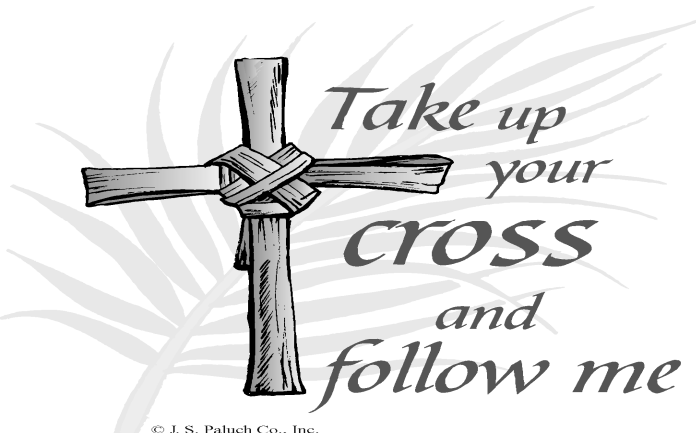

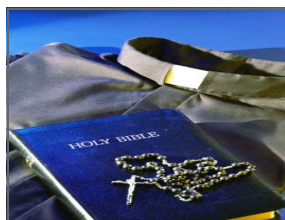
