## Why Was Jesus Baptized by John?

Last Sunday we celebrated the Feast of the Epiphany and rejoiced in the revelation of Jesus to the Gentile world in the persons of the Magi. He came for all persons, regardless of their nationality, gender, or religious persuasion.

Today we recall His Baptism in the Jordan by John. This event has numerous possible directions to go in exploring what we are to learn from the story.

First of all, we need to understand that baptism for sin was not uncommon at the time of Jesus. Many itinerant preachers baptized folks as a connection with conversion of heart. Yet, these various spiritual events are not to be understood as sacramental happenings. They were individual events between the person(s) baptized and God.

John was a tad uncomfortable baptizing Jesus. John knew that Jesus outranked him! There is a short dialogue between the two men and John does concede to baptize Jesus. John knows that his cousin is greater than he and really ought to be the one baptizing him! Yet, he accepts the request and Jesus enters the waters of the Jordan like the rest of the people seeking forgiveness of sins.

Why, you might ask, did Jesus do this? He models for us the need to ask for forgiveness of sins and to acknowledge that we are sinners. Today people speak about being wounded or broken and think that is adequate. If it were, we would need to re-write the theology of redemption. Being wounded or broken implies that another person did this to us and that we really have no culpability for what we have done. When we accept the fact that we are God's chosen sinners, then the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus makes sense. We are redeemed because our sins have been forgiven!

The voice from heaven speaks of the identity of Jesus. The voice says, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him."

This is the message of today's Gospel reading: that we LISTEN to Jesus! And how do we do this? It is really quite simple. We open the ears of our hearts to hear what the Spirit wants to say to us. We listen for the call to on-going conversion which demands sorrow for sins and reparation for them. We make use of the sacrament of reconciliation.

It also means that we listen with the ears of our hearts to the readings each week and amend our lives according to the suggestions of the Spirit. If we choose to have another primary interpretation of this Gospel story, we may well miss the point!

**We need to stop playing God;  
we are imminently unqualified!**

## ¿Por Qué Fue Jesús Bautizado por Juan?

El domingo pasado celebramos la Festividad de la Epifanía y nos regocijamos en la revelación de Jesús hacia el mundo de los Gentiles en las personas de los Reyes Magos. El vino al mundo para todos, sin importar su nacionalidad, género o persuasión religiosa.

Hoy recordamos el Bautizo de Jesús en el Jordán hecho por Juan. Este suceso tiene numerosas direcciones posibles que nos llevan a explorar lo que podemos aprender de esta historia.

Antes que nada, necesitamos entender que el bautizo para el perdón de los pecados no era usual en aquellos tiempos de Jesús. Muchos predicadores itinerantes bautizaban gente como una conexión para la conversión del corazón. Sin embargo, estos diversos eventos espirituales no eran interpretados como actos sacramentales. Si no eran eventos individuales entre la persona que se hacía bautizar y Dios.

Juan se sentía un poco incomodo bautizando a Jesús. ¡Juan sabía que Jesús lo superaba a él! Existe un breve diálogo entre ambos hombres y Juan finalmente accede bautizar a Jesús. Juan sabe que su primo es mucho más grande que él y sabía que el que debía ser realmente bautizado era él. Pero el acepta lo que Jesús le pide y así Jesús entra en las aguas del Río Jordán como el resto de las personas buscando el perdón de los pecados.

Tal vez te has de preguntar, ¿por qué hizo esto Jesús? El modela por nosotros la necesidad de pedir perdón de los pecados y que aceptemos que somos pecadores. Hoy en día la gente habla sobre estar herido o lastimado y piensan que eso es adecuado. Si as fuera, entonces necesitaríamos re-escribir la teología sobre la redención. Estar herido o lastimado implica que otra persona provoco esto y que entonces nosotros no tenemos culpabilidad de lo que hemos hecho. Cuando aceptamos que somos pecadores escogidos por Dios, entonces es cuando la vida, muerte y resurrección de Jesús llega a tener sentido. ¡Somos redimidos porque nuestros pecados han sido perdonados!

La voz del cielo habla de la identidad de Jesús. La voz dice, "Este es mi hijo amado, escúchenlo."

Este es el mensaje del Evangelio de hoy: ¡ESCUCHEMOS a Jesús! ¿Y cómo lo hacemos esto? Es bastante sencillo. Abrimos los oídos de nuestros corazones para escuchar lo que el Espíritu Santo nos quiere decir. Escuchamos el llamado para el transcurso de la conversión lo cual demanda sufrir por el pecado y reparar el daño. Hacemos uso del sacramento de la reconciliación.

Esto significa también que debemos escuchar con los oídos del corazón a las escrituras de cada semana y enmendar nuestras vidas según lo que el Espíritu nos sugiere. Si escogemos tener otra interpretación primaria de esta historia del Evangelio, habremos perdido entonces el significado.

**¡Necesitamos parar de jugar a ser Dios;  
porque somos eminentemente incompetentes!**

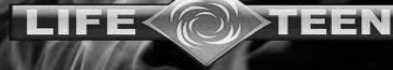

## Saint Hilary, Bishop and Doctor Feast Day, Thursday, January 13

Saint Hilary was born at Poitiers at the beginning of the fourth century. About the year 350 he was chosen bishop of that city, and for his vigorous fight against the Arians was exiled by the Emperor Constantine. He wrote works of wisdom and learning to strengthen the Catholic faith and interpret Scripture. He died in 367.

### **Excerpts from a sermon On the Trinity by St. Hilary...**

"I am well aware, almighty God and Father, that in my life I owe you a most particular duty. It is to make my every thought and word speak of you.

In fact, you have conferred on me this gift of speech, and it can yield no greater return than to be at your service. It is for making you known as Father, the Father of the only-begotten God, and preaching this to the world that knows you not and to the heretics who refuse to believe in you.

In this matter the declaration of my intention is only of limited value. For the rest, I need to pray for the gift of your help and your mercy. As we spread our sails of trusting faith and public avowal before you, fill them with the breath of your Spirit, to drive us on as we begin this course of proclaiming your truth. We have been promised, and he who made the promise is trustworthy; **Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.**

Yes, in our poverty we will pray for our needs. We will study the sayings of your prophets and apostles with unflagging attention, and knock for admittance wherever the gift of understanding is safely kept. But yours it is, Lord, to grant our petitions, to be present when we seek you and to open when we knock.

So we trust in you to inspire the beginnings of this ambitious venture, to strengthen its progress, and to call us into a partnership in the spirit with the prophets and the apostles. To that end, may we grasp precisely what they meant to say, taking each word in its real and authentic sense. For we are about to say what they already have declared as part of the mystery of revelation: that you are the eternal God, the Father of the eternal, only-begotten God; that you are one and not born from another; and that the Lord Jesus is also one, born of you from all eternity. We must not proclaim a change in truth regarding the number of gods. We must not deny that he is begotten of you who are the one God; nor must we assert that he is other than the true God, born of you who are truly God the Father.

Impart to us, the, the meaning of the words of Scripture and the light to understand it, with reverence for the doctrine and confidence in its truth. Grant that we may express what we believe. Through the prophets and apostles we know about you, the one God the Father, and the one Lord Jesus Christ. May we have the grace, in the face of heretics who deny you, to honor you as God, who is not alone, and to proclaim this as truth."

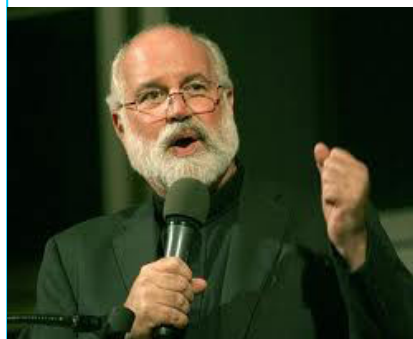
