Trinity Sunday

“God so loved the world...”

Today we reflect on the love of God which became incarnate for us so that we might be redeemed and enter into a relationship of intimacy with the Triune God. In the Gospel reading we heard a line that is well known but not truly lived with understanding.

“...God so loved the world that he gave his only son...”

If we read the words thoughtfully and then reflect on them, we realize that we have a clear statement of the relationship between God the Father and God the Son. It is a relationship of love – love that is unconditional. That love we call the Spirit.

Today we are reminded that we worship a God who is Three Persons in One God. It is not three people – it is three PERSONS. It is not three personalities – it is three PERSONS. We can wrestle with the philosophical component of these attempts to define the God in whom we believe. But the truth is that the Trinity is a MYSTERY! It is beyond human comprehension. We can try to use imagery that helps us accept the mystery, but we can't explain the mystery.

Perhaps the best way to speak of the Trinity is to look at each PERSON of the Trinity separately and come to a clearer understanding of who God is.

We speak of the Father who is our Creator. There are numerous images used for this, including those found in the first two chapters of Genesis where God creates the world and all that is in it. The Gospel of John begins with the lines: “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.” Clearly this Word is separate from, yet, in union with God. John continues saying that “the Word became flesh and dwelt among us.” We recognize this as Jesus of Nazareth, the Word became Flesh. John makes certain that we understand the reason for this incarnation. “He came unto his own, but his own received him not. But to those who did receive him, he gave the power to become the children of God.” The Gospel then continues to describe His becoming flesh and living among us and then becoming children of God.

As the Gospel continues we meet the Trinity in the Last Discourses. We learn that another advocate will come. Another PERSON of God will be with us to continue God's creating work with us. Yet this third PERSON will not be the Father! Here we meet the Holy Spirit.

Let us continue to ponder this great Mystery this week.

La Santísima Trinidad

“Porque tanto amo Dios al mundo...”

Hoy reflexionamos sobre el amor de Dios el cual se encarno por nosotros para que pudiéramos ser redimidos y poder entrar en una relación íntima con el Dios Trinitario. En la lectura del Evangelio escuchamos una frase que es muy reconocida, pero no verdaderamente vivida con entendimiento.

“Porque tanto amo Dios al mundo, que dio a su único hijo...”

Si leemos estas palabras cuidadosamente y las reflexionamos, nos damos cuenta que tenemos una declaración clara sobre la relación entre el Dios Padre y el Dios Hijo. Es una clara relación de Amor-amor incondicional. A ese Amor le llamamos Espíritu.

Hoy se nos recuerda que nosotros adoramos a un Dios que es Tres Personas en un Solo Dios. No son tres personas, sino un PERSONA en tres. No hay tres personalidades porque es una sola PERSONA en tres. Podemos luchar con los componentes filosóficos de estas afirmaciones para poder definir al Dios en el que creemos. Pero la verdad es que la Trinidad es un MISTERIO! Y este misterio va más allá de la razón humana. Podemos usar imágenes que nos ayuden a aceptar el misterio pero no a entenderlo.

Tal vez la mejor manera para hablar sobre la Trinidad es mirando por separado a cada PERSONA de la Trinidad y obtener así un entendimiento más claro de quien es Dios en realidad.

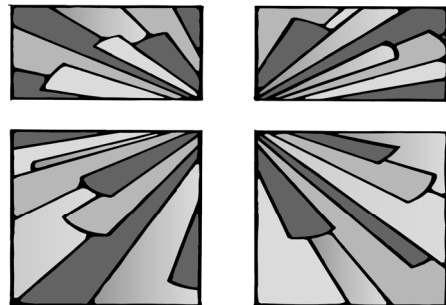
Hablamos del Padre que es el Creador. Hay una infinidad de imágenes utilizadas para esto, incluyendo aquellas encontradas en los primeros capítulos del libro del Génesis en donde Dios crea el mundo y todo lo que existe en él. El Evangelio de San Juan inicia con estas líneas: “Al principio existía la Palabra y la Palabra estaba junto a Dios y la Palabra era Dios” Esta claro que esta Palabra es separada de lo que estaba hasta entonces en unión con Dios. San Juan continua diciendo “Y la Palabra se hizo carne y habitó entre nosotros.” Y esta encarnación la reconocemos como Jesús de Nazaret, la Palabra hecha carne. San Juan se asegura que entendamos esta razón de esta encarnación. “Vino a los suyos y los suyos, no la recibieron. Pero a todos los que la recibieron, a los que creen en su Nombre, les dio el poder de llegar a ser hijos de Dios. Luego, el Evangelio continua describiendo como El se hizo carne y como siguió habitando entre nosotros y los que se convierten en hijos del Dios.

Mientras el Evangelio continua, conocemos a la Trinidad en sus Últimos Discursos y descubrimos que otro defensor vendrá. Otra PERSONA de Dios estará con nosotros para continuar el trabajo de la creación de Dios con nosotros. De manera que esta tercera PERSONA no será el Padre! Aquí es cuando nos encontramos con el Espíritu Santo.

Durante esta semana, continuemos reflexionando en este gran Misterio.
