**Emergency Relief
Japan Earthquake and Tsunami**

The magnitude 8.9 offshore quake triggered a 23 foot (seven meter) tsunami and was followed for hours and days by more than 100 aftershocks, many of them more than magnitude 6.0 . The Northeastern coastal city of Sendai, the city in Miyagi pre-fecture, or state, was the closest to the epicenter. Catholic Relief Service (CRS) personnel throughout the Pacific are standing ready to assist those affected by the earthquake and tsunami that struck Japan ear Friday morning. The Fourth Week of Lent

Can you believe that we are nearly half way through this holy season of Enlightenment and Purification which we call Lent? In this fourth word of Jesus we hear something that we tend to interpret from a purely psychological frame of reference. Yet taking time to recall the whole of this psalm may well give us a better understanding of the words attributed to Jesus.

**“My God, my God, Why have you forsaken me?”
(Matthew 27:46)**

This word of Jesus is a line from one of the Psalms (22) which asks for help and tells us that “since birth you are my God.” We often think of this word as the expression of Jesus’ feeling abandoned by His Father. Perhaps he did! But he spoke of it through the Psalm prayer which tells us that “God has not spurned or disdained the misery of this poor wretch.”

The Psalm goes on to say: “I will live forever for the Lord; ... [my descendants will] proclaim to a people yet unborn the deliverance you have brought.”

Do I truly believe this? Do I believe that through his passion, death, and resurrection Jesus has indeed won our redemption?

This is what Jesus calls us as God’s chosen sinners to hear. Jesus indeed made certain that we will be among those whose “hearts [will] enjoy life forever!” Jesus calls me to accept the fact that HE redeemed me! God does indeed love ME! Do I believe this in the depths of my heart?

This word calls me to deepen my own knowledge of the Psalm so that I can pray as Jesus did! He prayed the words of the Psalms. He prayed them as the Jewish community did; not as he would like them to be prayed. Those psalms which sound so violent were part of the prayer of Israel and were also part of the prayer of Jesus. Israel prayed with her whole heart (the peaceful and the violent dimensions) and offered these prayers to her God.

What do I do when I find this repugnant – this praying in a violent manner? I turn to my God in the depths of my sinful being.

Loving God, I invite you into the core of my sinful being. There I beg you to love me into the image you created me to be. May this word, Most Loving God, a word so hard to hear, remind me of how great you are!

En la cuarta palabra de Jesús escuchamos algo que tenemos la tendencia de interpretar de una forma de referencia psicológico puro. Aun tomando tiempo en recordar la salma entera puede darnos un entendimiento mejor de la palabras atribuidas a Jesús.

**“Dios Mío, Dios Mío, ¿por que me has desamparado?”
(Mateo 27:46)**

Esta palabra de Jesús es un línea de una de la Salmas (22) en donde pide ayuda y nos dice que “desde nacimiento eres mi Dios.” Muchas veces pensamos de esta palabra como una expresión de Jesús sintiéndose abandonado por Su Padre. ¡Puede ser que así fue! Pero el hablo de el por la oración del Salmo que nos dice que “Dios no ha despreciado o desdeñarse de la miseria de este pobre desdichado.”

El Salma continua diciendo: “Yo viviré para siempre por el Señor;...{mis descendientes proclamaran a un pueblo todavía sin nacer la salvación que tu has traído.”

En verdad, ¿creo esto? ¿Creo yo que por su pasión, muerte y resurrección Jesús ha verdaderamente ganado nuestra redención?

Esto es lo que Jesús nos llama a escuchar como los pecadores escogidos de Dios: Claro esta que Jesús, acertó con toda seguridad que nosotros estuviéremos entre aquellos cuyos “corazones gozaran de la vida para siempre!” ¡Jesús me llama para aceptar el echo que El me redimió! ¡Dios en verdad ME ama! ¿Creo esto desde lo mas hondo de mi corazón?

Esta palabra me llama a profundizar mi conocimiento del Salmo para que yo pueda orar como lo izo Jesús. El rezo la palabras de los Salmos. El los rezo como la comunidad Judío los rezaba; no como el quería que se rezaran. Estos salmos que suenan violentos eran parte de la oración de Israel y también eran parte de la oración de Jesús. Israel oraba con todo su corazón (las dimensiones pacíficas y violentas) y ofreció estas oraciones a su Dios.

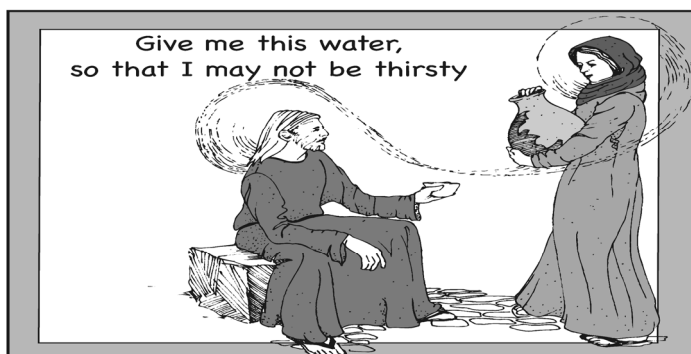
¿Que hago cuando encuentro esto repugnante — esto orando en una manera violenta? Yo volteo a mi Dios en la profundidad de me ser pecador.
